**Job Description:**

The primary role of a camp leader is to be responsible for the care and custody of children 6-13 years of age and to conduct programs for them. It is expected that leaders will work co-operatively and creatively in providing for the needs of the children in their cabins and in the camp as a whole. Where necessary, leaders may be asked to assist in program areas at the discretion of the Director or other Camp Staff. At the end of camp, leaders will participate in an evaluation, focused both on their performance and their suggestions for improving camp life.

**Selection of Leaders:**

Leaders-in-Training are 14 and 15 years of age and Cabin Leaders must be 16 years of age or older. ***Please note that all Leaders-in-Training must be 14 years of age by the first day of camp.***

Please complete this application form and submit it to Janelle Shaw, our Leadership Co-ordinator. Applicants will be interviewed and references are required. It is our hope that leaders will be available for a minimum of two camp sessions, though this is not a requirement for application. ***Prospective leaders are expected to be present for pre-camp training sessions, known as Model Camp. This year's Model Camp will be held from Friday, July 15<sup>th</sup> to Sunday, July 17<sup>th</sup>.*** This is mandatory for ALL Leaders and Leaders-in-Training. Final determination of the leadership readiness for each participant will occur following Model Camp.
